

APT General Meeting Minutes

I Welcome and Call to Order – Francie Donkerbrook

- Meeting called to order at 5:32 pm.

II Principal’s Update – Nick Noonan

- Projected Enrollment – highest capacity in district 940 students projected. 954 capacity.
- Large incoming 6th grade from feeder schools.
- 6th and 8th grade open enrollment on wait list.
- Override passed so that is good news.
- New superintendent search has begun.
- In 2020, 3 seats for Governing Board.

III Teacher Update – Laynee Lagner

- Spirit t-shirts for \$5 - Teachers found the site to be glitchy and couldn’t order shirts.
- Staff Room – the main staff room has been equipped in the past by APT with plastic/disposable utensils. Can APT do that again?
- Crazy 4 Cocopah – Concerned about kids being a bit crazy one teacher found. They think carnival is better and request to go back to that. They enjoyed teacher in a jail. Committee with teachers and parents would be good for next year.
- Classroom baskets – Teachers are concerned but simpler than realized.
- Winterfest – Concerned that Winterfest is on a Saturday, but we are trying for this year and see how it goes. Will try to get one teacher per grade level to come. Consider pulling in from feeder schools. Maybe have Club Tables setup.

IV Financial Overview – Pat Moraca

- Budget Update
 - We have just under \$117,000 in account.
 - Checks outstanding \$563.50
 - Crazy 4 Cocopah approximately \$1600 to be paid.
- Other Updates
 - Few teacher supply requests received.
 - Budget plan this year of spending is \$90,000. We may not spend that this year based on requests received so far.
 - Mrs. Lagner asked if Tax Credit can be used for Poet request for 7th grade, cost \$3500-\$4000 for 4 days.

V Spirit Wear – Rio / Francie Donkerbrook

- Scrunchies came in today
- Hoodies maybe \$17
- Stickers wanted small
- Lanyards – feedback that kids think they are too expensive.

VI Fundraising – Christy Wright

- Looking for creative help with baskets. Drama group to help.
- Pricing for raffle ticket prices in the past there was a kid basket section that were less expensive, and an adult basket section that were more expensive. Price point may depend on who is buying tickets and chance.⁴
 - Suggested ticket prices: \$5 for 1 ticket / 5 tickets for \$20 / 15 tickets for \$50 / 40 tickets for \$100
- Teachers will consider putting together a candy basket for a cheaper option for tickets for kids - \$1 tickets.
- Looking at Costco fundraiser, but it is different.
- Reach-a-thon – need help on prize donation, reading hour. Similar to a marathon. Kids to ask parents, grandparents to donate in January. February 9 Reading hour.
- Silent Auction. Adult event on March 20. Teacher experiences to be auctioned off.
- Christy needs help with Fundraising.
- Mrs. Lagner will send an email asking for help for Christy.
